



## Lab Biohazardous Spill Protocol for Spill NOT in a BSC with Evacuation

### Immediate Response

- 1) STOP all work and alert others
- 2) If medical attention is needed, call 911
- 3) Remove all PPE and contaminated clothing and place in biohazard container
- 4) Clean hands thoroughly \_\_\_\_\_
- 5) Post DO NOT ENTER sign
- 6) Evacuate room
- 7) If necessary, shower

### Clean Up

- 1) Wait \_\_\_\_\_ before re-entry
- 2) Put on clean PPE: \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) Cover spill with absorbent material soaked in \_\_\_\_\_
- 4) Pour \_\_\_\_\_ around spill
- 5) Let stand for \_\_\_\_\_
- 6) Use tools (tongs, broom, dustpan) to pick up sharp hazards
  - Place medical sharps in the sharps container 
  - Place decontaminated non-medical sharps in a cardboard box  with 1-2 plastic liners
- 7) Place any contaminated materials into biohazard bag(s)
- 8) Decontaminate PPE and contaminated clothing from Immediate Response #3
  - Eye protection and other reusable items with \_\_\_\_\_
  - Disposables by \_\_\_\_\_
- 9) Decontaminate biohazard bag(s), disinfectant container, tools, and any contact surfaces with \_\_\_\_\_

### Wrap Up

- 1) Remove and disinfect PPE worn during clean up, if contaminated
- 2) Clean hands thoroughly \_\_\_\_\_
- 3) Report Incident to PI
- 4) Report Incident using the First Report of Biological Exposure or Release form within 24 hours
